Dear Seattle School Board & Selection Committee:

I feel it necessary to clarify information regarding our staff. Seattle Parks and Recreation Department does not contract out our staff to any site outside our system. There are various reasons for this utmost being the liability implications and due to the City's current budget challenges it would be absolutely impossible to provide any kind of staffing outside our facilities.

Garfield Campus Advisory Council has agreed to work with Mitchell's House and CCC@MLK on coordinating Seattle Youth Violence Prevention Initiative programming between Garfield Teen Life Center on Garfield Campus and Martin Luther King Jr Community Center. This collaboration will give the Central Area two locations to work with our young people on this and other issues.

There currently are no other arrangements and/or negotiations verbally or otherwise being made with any other entity in the Central Area or within the Central Division of the Seattle Parks and Recreation system related to the Martin Luther King Jr. School site. As a representative for the Central Area, which where this site is located, any measures, arrangements and/or negotiations would come through me and/or other members of Garfield Campus Advisory Council.
